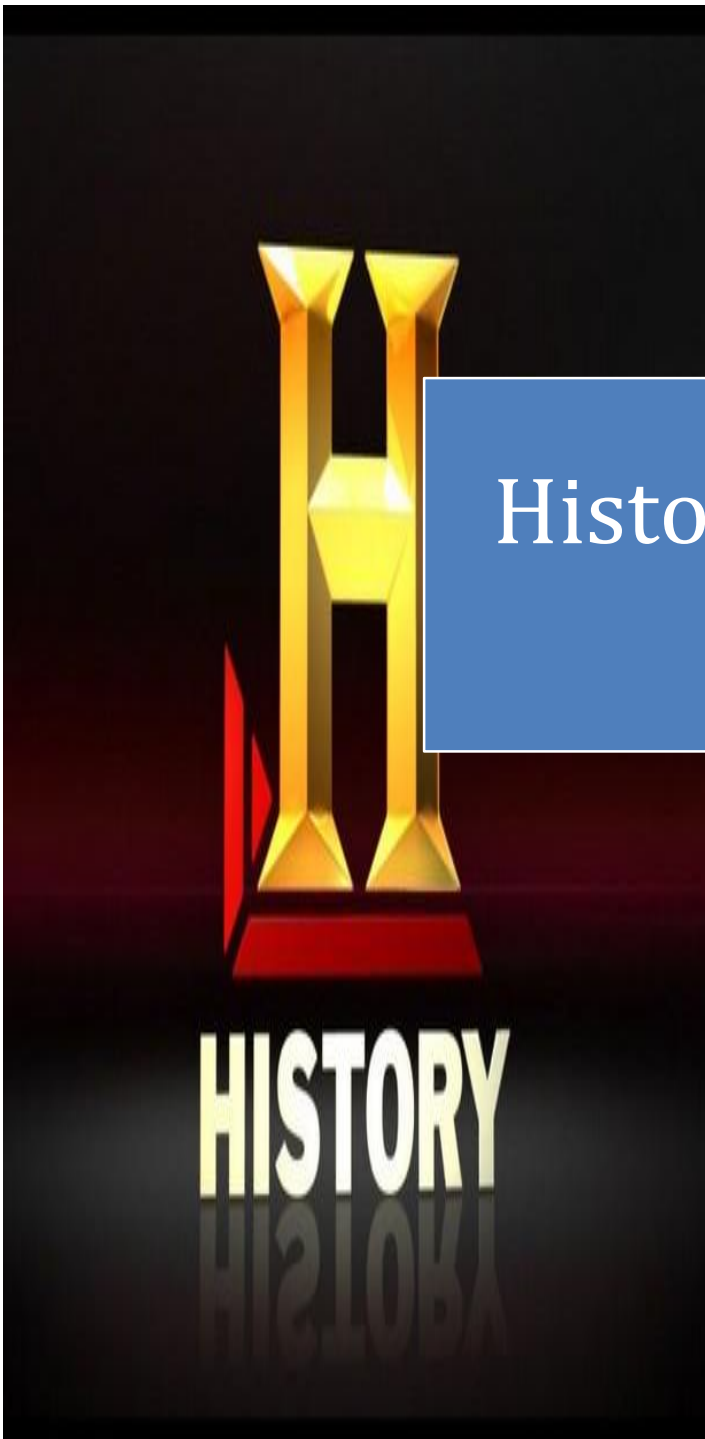

Leaving Cert History

- We offer a one year or two year course in Leaving Certificate Higher Level History
- We recommend this course to students who have a real interest in History but are restricted by subject choices in their present school.

Course

We offer the Later Modern History course 1815-1993. Students study a prescribed document question and three other topics for their course.

Including the document based study students will take two Irish topics & two topics from Europe and the wider world.

ASSESSMENT

There are two assessment components, a report on research study and a terminal exam. The total marks for the research project is 20%.

The research study is strictly supervised. Strict authentication procedures are in place. Non-compliance with these procedures will result in refusal to submit project and loss of marks.
